Title: Report of the Community Grants Evaluation Committee: 2016 Community Grant Recommendations

Objective: To review recommendations of the Community Grants Evaluation Committee for awarding of 2016 grants.

Background: A Community Grants Evaluation Committee was established for the 2016 grants process. This committee was tasked with providing recommendations to Council for awarding of 2016 grants within the budget approved by Council on February 22, 2016.

The Committee will continue to meet over the next few months to complete a report to Council for input into the new draft Community Grants policy.

Analysis: The committee held three meetings and has summarized its recommendations below. A summary of all grant requests received and considered is also attached.

All groups that have been denied or whose funding has been reduced from their original request will be provided a formal letter. Any group wanting to appeal their decision will be allowed to present their information through the Finance & Labour Relations Subcommittee. Staff has included a recommendation for Committee to consider which would allow future reconsideration of any of the community grants, without formally triggering the reconsideration rules in Council's procedural by-law.

Financial Impact: The 2016 grants budget was approved by Council previously. All recommendations fit into the approved budget of \$723,894.

Evaluation Committee Recommendations:

- 1. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$7,000 be provided for Canada Day Celebrations for the parade and fireworks
- 2. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$43,000 be provided to Gallery Stratford for programs and operational support.
- 3. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$500 be provided for Stratford Festival Guthrie Award scholarship benefiting a young Stratford resident studying theatre.
- 4. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$1,000 be provided for Kiwanis Festival of the Performing Arts to provide financial assistance for Stratford participants to attend the Ontario Music Festival Association competition.
- 5. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$500 be provided for Kiwanis Garlic Festival for promotion.
- 6. That a 2016 grant request of \$1,000 by INNERchamber, to fund various expenses and the Composer-in-Residence program, be denied.
- 7. That a 2016 grant request of \$24,200 by the Multicultural Association of Perth and Huron, to provide operational costs for programs assisting with integration of new immigrants and refugees to Stratford and area, be denied.
- 8. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$700 be provided for Music and Opera Appreciation to support the involvement of live artists from the Stratford area in its programming.
- 9. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$2,000 be provided for Off The Wall Stratford Artists Alliance to support its marketing initiative to students.
- 10. That a 2016 grant request of \$2,700 by Playmakers! Theatre School, to support students who require financial assistance and to fund new program content, be denied.
- 11. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$1,500 be provided for Santa's Parade of Lights to cover bands, advertising, signage and audio visual.
- 12. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of up to \$5,506 be provided for SpringWorks Festival to cover rental costs of City facilities and City fees.
- 13. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$1,500 be provided for Stratford Concert Band to aid basic operations, purchase music, advertise concerts and secure guest performers.

- 14. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$8,000 be provided for Stratford International Children's Theatre Festival (World Festival of Children's Theatre) to assist with operational expenses.
- 15. That a 2016 City in-kind grant of up to \$10,000 be provided for Stratford International Children's Theatre Festival (World Festival of Children's Theatre) to assist with fees for various City services.
- 16. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$20,000 be provided to Stratford Summer Music to fund free music performances and events.
- 17. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$6,500 be provided for Stratford Symphony Orchestra to support operational costs.
- 18. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$7,500 be provided to the Ontario Heritage Conference as part of the Conference Allocation grants budget.
- 19. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$15,000 be provided for Conference Allocation under Council Policy A.1.11 Civic Conventions and Receptions.
- 20. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$10,700 be provided to Civic Beautification & Environmental Awareness Committee to assist with insurance costs and support its river lights project.

- 22. That a 2016 in-kind grant request of \$1,000 by the Canadian Cancer Society for its Relay for Life event, to cover City fees related to tent permits and hanging banners, be denied.
- 23. That a 2016 grant request of \$3,000 by Community Living Stratford and Area, to offset the cost of public transportation for its clients, be denied.
- 24. That a 2016 grant request of \$9,500 by the Family Services Perth-Huron, to provide financial assistance to Stratford residents requiring counselling services, be denied.
- 25. That a 2016 grant request of \$20,000 by Heart To Care, to provide a web resource centre for families dealing with dementia, be denied.
- 26. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of \$3,000 be provided to the Kiwanis Club of Stratford, to offset rental charges for use of the Kiwanis Community Centre.

- 27. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$3,000 be provided to the Local Community Food Centre to support the expansion of the Loving Spoonfuls program designed for teaching new and expecting mothers to cook healthy and affordable food.
- 28. That a 2016 in-kind grant request of \$234 by the MS Society, Stratford-Perth MS Walk, to cover City fees related to sign and street permits, be denied.
- 29. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$11,000 be provided to ONE CARE Home & Community Support Services, to support accessible van transportation to Stratford residents.
- 30. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of \$500 be provided for Stratford City Centre BIA for the opening and use of City Hall restrooms during Canada Day Celebrations in Market Square.
- 31. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of \$500 be provided for Stratford City Centre BIA for the opening and use of City Hall restrooms during the Outdoor Christmas Market in Market Square.
- 32. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$5,000 be provided for the Stratford Perth Community Foundation to support outreach to engage potential philanthropy, community awareness and support local organizations.
- 33. That an amount of \$25,000. be included in the 2016 grants budget for Residential Hospice in accordance with Council resolution # R2015-550 dated November 23, 2015.
- 34. That a 2016 grant in the amount of \$350 be provided for the Poppy Trust Fund, Royal Canadian Legion Branch #8, which assists veterans and their families with bursaries and medical equipment.
- 35. That a 2016 grant in the amount of \$27,000 be provided to the United Way Perth-Huron to support its ongoing programs.
- 36. That a 2016 grant request of \$1,776 by Adult Learning Programs of Perth, to provide additional funding to cover expected increases to the number of clients served and instruction hours, be denied.
- 37. That an amount of \$25,000 be included in the 2016 grants budget for the Stratford-Perth Humane Society loan forgiveness in accordance with Council resolution # R2015-081 dated February 23, 2015.

- 40. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of up to \$5,000 be provided for Stratford Roller Sports Alliance for a dry-pad rental subsidy.

- 45. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of up to \$6,000 be provided for Stratford Lawn Bowling Club to offset rental cost.
- 46. That a 2016 City in-kind grant in the amount of up to \$6,000 be provided to Stratford Lions Club to offset rental cost of Packham Road Complex, as part of the grants contingency budget.
- 47. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$2,000 be provided to Junior Achievement London & District for delivery of programs to develop financial literacy and leadership skills in Stratford high school students.
- 48. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$500 be provided to the Stratford Chefs School for its scholarship initiative that supports a Stratford student.
- 49. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$28,638 be provided for the grants contingency budget to assist with funding after-budget requests.
- 50. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$6,600 be provided to the Canadian Dairy XPO, comprised of \$5,000 for the Cheesefest function and up to \$1,606 for in-kind policing services; as part of the Conference Allocation grants budget.

51. That a 2016 City grant in the amount of \$250,000 be provided to Stratford General Hospital for its 2016 pledge instalment.

That following the decision of Council regarding the 2016 Grant Requests, that any appeals from applicants be forwarded to the Finance and Labour Relations Sub-committee to hear the appeals and to make a recommendation for the Finance and Labour Relations Committee's consideration; and That appeals should include any new or additional information not previously considered by the Community Grants Evaluation Committee.
