- Develop operational climate change framework

Products of the 2022 Internal Working Group

Development of a Corporate Climate Change Framework

- Develop necessary policies and procedures required adopt and utilize climate change green house gas reduction plan
- Establish goals and objectives specific to Stratford with the intent to establish a baseline and methods to track success
- Define measurements that are corporately consistent ensuring a uniform approach and aligning with Provincial & Federal frameworks
- Identify subgroups and draft their mandate and high-level goals
- Review funding sources and adjust approach to maximize success
- Determine anticipated reporting and auditing requirements



Anticipated Position for 2023

Establish Sub-Working Groups

- Government, Building and Land Use, Business and Industry,
 Transportation, Waste, Natural Environment and Agriculture
- Smaller groups lead by internal staff to achieve specific goals

Build Template for Funding Strategies

 Develop an understanding that can be used corporately in approach to fund projects and initiatives

Identify Resource Requirements

- Determine expectations and limitations required to achieve goals
- Generate resource requirements for 2023 budget
