MINOR VARIANCE APPLICATIONS

A06-22- 514 Mornington Street - Planner: Miranda Ivany

Purpose: The purpose of this application under Section 44 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 is to increase the gross floor area for a proposed second suite in an existing single-detached dwelling.

Variances requested:

1. To increase the gross floor area of a proposed second suite from 100 m2 square meters to 119 m2.




A07-22- 1041 Erie Street - Planner: Jeff Bannon

Purpose: The purpose of this application under Section 44 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 is to reduce the front yard setback to the existing building and to increase the maximum width of a driveway.

Variances requested:

- 1. To reduce the front yard setback from 13.8 metres to 13.4 metres.
- To increase the maximum width of a driveway from 10 metres to 12.45 metres for the northern driveway and 12.39 metres for the southern driveway.



A08-22- 904 Downie Street - Planner: Jeff Bannon

Purpose: The purpose of this application under Section 44 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 is to reduce the front yard setback to the parking area, the minimum size of a parallel parking space and to reduce the minimum length of a parking space.

Variances requested:

- 1. To reduce the front yard setback to the parking area from 7.5 metres to 6.5 metres.
- 2. To reduce the minimum length of a parallel parking space from 6.8 metres to 6.52 metres.
- 3. To reduce the minimum width of a parallel parking space from 2.8 metres to 2.74 metres.
- 4. To reduce the minimum length of a parking space from 5.6 metres to 4 metres.

Changes to the *Municipal Act* allows the Committee of Adjustment to participate in open meetings electronically and be counted for the purposes of quorum during emergencies declared locally or provincially under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*. If the emergency declared is terminated prior to the hearing, the public meeting will then be held in the City of Stratford Council Chambers in City Hall, 1 Wellington Street, Stratford, or at an alternative location subject to direction from the Province and Huron Perth Public Health, on the date and time the meeting is currently scheduled.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Secretary-Treasurer, Stratford Committee of Adjustment, Jeff Bannon, 82 Erie Street, 2nd Floor Stratford, ON N5A 2M4. This will also entitle you to be advised of a possible Ontario Land Tribunal hearing. Even if you are the successful party, you should request a copy of the decision since the Stratford Committee of Adjustment decision may be appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal by the applicant or another member of the public.
