#### MINOR VARIANCE APPLICATIONS

#### A15-22-34 BIRMINGHAM STREET - PLANNER: MIRANDA IVANY

Purpose: The purpose of this application under Section 44 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 is to reduce the rear yard depth for the construction of a 1-storey addition to an existing single detached dwelling.

## Variances requested:

1. To reduce the rear yard depth from 7.5m to 6.5m for the construction of a 1-storey addition.



#### A16-22-549 NELSON STREET- PLANNER: MIRANDA IVANY

# **CONSENT APPLICATIONS**

#### **B06-22 –149 HURON STREET - PLANNER: MIRANDA IVANY**

The purpose of this application is to sever an 18 square meter portion at the rear of the subject property to convey as a lot addition to the southernly abutting lands, known municipally as 46 Norman Street, Stratford. The retained parcel will have a frontage of 12m and a lot area of approximately 409 square meters. The lot to be enlarged would have an area of approximately 1350 meters squared.
