HAVE YOUR SAY IN THE NEXT STRATFORD MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION

The next Municipal and School Board Election takes place on October 24, 2022, and the City of Stratford is providing notice in accordance with section 40 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, of the following important voting information:

How to Vote

Voting in the 2022 Stratford Municipal and School Board Election can be completed using the internet or telephone. These two methods allow eligible electors to vote anytime during the voting period from anywhere with internet or telephone access. You can vote from the comfort of your own home using your computer, laptop, tablet, smart phone, or touchtone telephone.

Eligible electors on the Voters' List will receive a Voter Information Letter in the mail in early October. This letter will contain important information including a Personalized Identification Number (PIN), which you will use along with your date of birth to access the voting system. The letter will also contain the designated internet address or telephone number needed to cast your vote. To ensure you receive your letter, **check your details on the voters' list** by using the Online Voter Services tool at www.stratford.ca/elections. Individuals not on the list will need to complete an Application to Amend the Voters' List Form EL15. Applications can currently be filled out and completed in the City Clerk's Office located on the Ground Floor of Stratford City Hall, Monday to Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

When to Vote

The Voting Period will begin Friday, October 14 at 10:00 am and end on Election Day, Monday, October 24 at 8:00 pm.

SEEKING JOINT COMPLIANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE APPLICANTS - REMINDER

The City of Stratford, Town of St. Marys, Municipality of North Perth, Township of Perth East, Township of Perth South, and Municipality of West Perth are currently seeking interested applicants for appointment to the Joint Compliance Audit Committee for the 2022 Municipal Election.

Applicants with a background in accounting, auditing or law are encouraged to apply. Please note that those individuals running for office in Municipal Elections for any of the participating municipalities, or who have conducted audits or provided financial advice in respect of Municipal Elections for any of the participating municipalities or candidates will be disqualified.

The purpose of the Joint Compliance Audit Committee is to:

- Consider compliance audit applications, decide whether they should be granted or rejected:
- · Appoint an auditor if the application is granted;
- Receive the auditor's report;
- Consider the auditor's report and decide if legal proceedings should be commenced; and
- Advise Council if the auditor's report indicates that there were no apparent contraventions and if there appears to be no reasonable grounds for the application.

The term of the Committee will commence in 2022 and continue through to 2026. Municipal Election Candidates have until Monday May 1, 2023 to file their Financial Statements. Any requests for a Compliance Audit will occur after that date. **The remuneration will be an established per diem rate (plus mileage).**

Applications can be completed online at the Perth County website, or a copy obtained by contacting the City of Stratford's Clerk's Office at elections@stratford.ca. **The deadline to apply is 8:00 a.m., on Monday, September 19, 2022.**

CHECKING YOUR INFORMATION ON THE VOTERS' LIST AND APPLICATIONS TO UPDATE THE LIST - REMINDER

As of September 1st, and up until the close of voting, electors can verify their own elector details on the City's election webpage, www.stratford.ca/elections, using the Online Voter Services tool. When using this tool, an elector must enter their full name, date of birth, and

street address. If their information is correct and up to date on the Voters' List, it will confirm this on the screen in real time. If you cannot confirm your information, it is likely you are not on the list to vote and will need to complete an Application to Amend the Voters' List Form EL15 to apply to amend the Voters' list.

Applications to amend the Voters' List can be filled out and completed in the City Clerk's Office at City Hall, Monday to Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Please bring one document showing your name and Stratford address. A list of acceptable documentation showing your name and Stratford address is outlined on our website at the link below. Additional hours and locations where applications to amend the voters' list can be submitted will be communicated on the City's website.
