NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT - OPA001-22 - 3980 ROAD 111

City of Stratford Council will hold a public meeting on Wednesday, December 07, 2022 **at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers in City Hall, 1 Wellington Street, Stratford to hear all interested persons with respect to the Official Plan Amendment (OPA001-22) under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

This will be an electronic meeting. A link to watch the Council meeting live will be provided on the agenda which will be posted to the City's website. A video of the meeting will also be posted to the City's website once available.

For those persons who wish to participate orally at the public meeting, please contact the City Clerk at clerks@stratford.ca no later than **10:00 am on December 7, 2022. Following confirmation of the request to speak, details for participating in the meeting will be provided. During the meeting there will be an active chat function where any member of the public can provide written comments during the meeting. The comments received will be read by the moderator during the public comment portion of the public meeting. The applications affect the property with the municipal address of 3980 Road 111, located on the West side of Road 111 between Line 34 and the City boundary.**

The proposed plan of subdivision contains 70 street townhouse dwelling lots and one storm water management block. The proposed plan of subdivision is served by four new local streets with two access points to Road 111. Lot frontages for the street townhouses range from approximately 6m to 11.5m.

The proposed zone change application is to change the above described subject lands from a Urban Reserve (UR-4) Zone to a Residential Fourth Density (R4(1)) Zone. The Residential R4(1) Zone permits street townhouse dwellings with a minimum lot area of 180m² and a minimum lot frontage of 6m. A key map is attached.

If a person or public body does not make oral submission at a public meeting or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the By-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Stratford to the Ontario Land Tribunal.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the By-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT - Z08-22 - R4 ZONED PROPERTIES
