### Accessibility Advisory Committee

The City of Stratford is seeking applications from a person with a disability to fill a vacant citizen representative position on the Accessibility Advisory Committee to November 30, 2021.

The Accessibility Advisory Committee currently meets electronically on the first Tuesday of the month at 11:30 a.m. The purpose of the Committee is to improve opportunities for persons with disabilities and to provide for involvement in the identification, removal and prevention of barriers to full participation in the community. The Accessibility Advisory Committee is composed of 9 members, with a majority of the members being persons with disabilities as prescribed in the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005.
