CONSENT APPLICATION

B13-21 – 4253 Perth Line 36 – Planner: Rachel Bossie

The purpose of this application is to sever a residence surplus to a farm operation on 4253 Perth Line 36. The proposed severed lands would have an approximate frontage of 9.02 metres, an approximate depth of 220 metres and an approximate area of 5099.50 square metres.

The proposed retained lands would have a frontage of approximately 163 metres, an approximate depth of 1008 metres and an approximate area of 37.50 hectares (92.66 acres).

The retained lands contain a shed and barn (proposed to be used for storage) and the lands to be severed are occupied with a residential dwelling, and accessory structures.

Changes to the Municipal Act allows the Committee of Adjustment to participate in open meetings electronically and be counted for the purposes of quorum during emergencies declared locally or provincially under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act. If the emergency declared is terminated prior to the hearing, the public meeting will then be held in the City of Stratford Council Chambers in City Hall, 1 Wellington Street, Stratford, or at an alternative location subject to direction from the Province and Huron Perth Public Health, on the date and time the meeting is currently scheduled.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Secretary-Treasurer, Stratford Committee of Adjustment, Jeff Bannon, 82 Erie Street, 2nd Floor Stratford, ON N5A 2M4. This will also entitle you to be advised of a possible Ontario Land Tribunal hearing. Even if you are the successful party, you should request a copy of the decision since the Stratford Committee of Adjustment decision may be appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal by the applicant or another member of the public.
