**Architectural Style:** Georgian

**Architectural Description:** two storey red brick; hip roof with flat centre section; small brackets under the eaves; first floor; a hipped roof porch supported by round columns; the entrance is enclosed in a small porch with a pediment supported by brackets; the round posts are set on rectangular paneled bases; the door to the porch has narrow panes around a larger middle pane and sidelights and a transom; a two pane over two pane rectangular window with shutters is on either side of the entrance; second floor; three rectangular two over two paned windows with shutters; small console brackets set in pairs are under the roof.

The original section of the house at the back was built in 1855. This part of the house was built for Dr. David Waugh. John McCulloch, a Mayor, of Stratford lived here.
