Checks vehicles and equipment for proper performance and inspect equipment to detect faults and malfunctions. • Diagnoses faults or malfunctions using computerized and other testing equipment to determine extent of repair required. • Adjusts equipment, repairs or replaces defective parts, components or systems, using hand and power tools. • Tests repaired equipment for proper performance and to ensure that work meets manufacturers' specifications. • Performs scheduled maintenance service, such as cleaning, oil changes, lubrications and tune ups. • Services attachments and working tools such as blades and ploughs. • Prepares and maintains written work records such as parts lists and inspections sheets. • Moves equipment and vehicles in and out of work area. • Assists and maintains a safe work environment. • Performs other related duties as assigned.
