

# Trucking Routes



## Trucks Per Day

Truck Type	Existing	Proposed
Outgoing sludge/digestate tanker trucks	4	7 - 8
Incoming solid waste trucks	0	2 - 3
Incoming liquid waste trucks	0	<1
Outgoing residue/reject materials trucks	0	<1
Future curbside SSO collection trucks	0	2 - 3
<b>Total</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>13 - 16</b>

**Notes:** Chemical trucks will remain at 2 per year; no change.  
 Delivery truck/tanker trucks will remain at 1 per week; no change.  
 Proposed number of trucks are maximum total values, including existing truck traffic

- The intent is to minimize truck travel through the main City and heavily inhabited areas
- Currently, outgoing sludge/digestate is hauled off-site between April and November each year
- The proposed site changes will include year round hauling
- Queuing of trucks will be kept to a minimum
- The City of Stratford's anti-idling by-law will be followed by trucks servicing the site
