The early years are a time of extraordinary growth and development. Children's capacity for self-regulation—how they manage energy expenditure in response to stressors and then recover from the effort—becomes wired during these critical years. Trajectories are set early and once set, can be difficult to change later in life. Anyone concerned with the healthy development of a young child needs to pay close attention to the child's self- regulation. Unfortunately, self-regulation is often confused with self-control, which leads people to think that effective discipline is key. Behaviour modification techniques and programs designed to instill self-control in young children can have short-term success. However, this approach might also lead to more longer-term problems in mood, attention, and behaviour.

In this session **Crystal Carbino** will introduce us **to Stuart's Shanker Self-Reg**® process, that is grounded in new science, for developing growth-promoting modes of self-regulation, co-regulation, dealing with stress, and restoring.

Learn how to read, reframe, and respond to behaviour, strong emotions, dysregulation, and much more. Self-Reg is a pathway to enhancing resilience, motivation, learning, & well-being.
