HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION SATURDAY

The City of Stratford will be holding a drive-thru Household Hazardous Waste collection day Saturday September 16, for residents to drop-off materials that are corrosive, explosive, flammable or poisonous.

The collection will take place in the northwest parking lot of the Rotary Complex, 353 McCarthy Road West, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for things like:

- Paints (please do not bring empty containers), varnish, solvents, caulking, glue
- Fuels, antifreeze, brake fluid
- Used motor oil and filters
- Batteries (household, rechargeable, automotive)
- Household cleaners (i.e. bleach, oven cleaners)
 Fluorescent light bulbs/tubes
- Refillable and non-refillable propane tanks

Based on previous collections, we have observed the most vehicles and the longest wait times from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Fewer vehicles and shorter wait times are typically seen between noon and 2:00 p.m. Please note that hazardous waste will not be accepted at the Romeo Street landfill site.

BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY - REMINDER

With students heading back to school this week, vehicle and pedestrian traffic will be increasing across the City. As the safety of all pedestrians is of utmost importance, we ask that everyone please drive carefully and always remember to:

- Stay alert around school buses and in school safety zones.
- Obey proper rules at crossing guard locations and only proceed when crossing guards and pedestrians have completely crossed the road.
- Always be alert & aware of pedestrians drive slowly & be cautious around schools and crossings.
 Limit any distractions, remove headphones, put away cellphones and other distractions when crossing the street, make eye contact with drivers & pedestrians when in crossing zones.
- Look for signage and adhere to school zone areas identified as 'no parking' or 'no stopping'.
- Follow all instructions from the crossing guards, always wait for the crossing guard to stop traffic and indicate that it is safe to cross.

The City's crossing guards and parking enforcement officers work every day to uphold pedestrian and vehicle safety. We ask that you do your part to help make sure everyone stays safe.

CROSSING GUARD RECRUITMENT - EXTENDED

The City of Stratford continues to seek crossing guards to play an important role in helping children safely walk to and from school at various locations across the City. As a crossing guard, you would be responsible for:

- covering shifts at the morning school bell times for student arrival and afternoon school bell times for student dismissal.

 acting as an important safety figure and engaged member of the community.
