PARKING UPDATE

Free parking in the City of Stratford ends on August 30, 2020. This means that starting Monday, August 31, 2020 payment at parking meters and pay by plate machines will be required.

The parking rate at on-street parking spaces is \$1.50/hr and the rate in lots is \$1.25/hr.

All other provisions of the Traffic and Parking By-law, including maximum parking time limits, no-parking and nostopping areas, continue to be in effect.

As a friendly reminder, if you are parking in an area with a 4-hour limit, you must move your vehicle before that 4-hour time limit has expired. Failure to do so could result in a parking ticket being issued. All maximum parking time limits are being enforced.

Enforcement of the By-law is as follows:

- From November 1 to March 31 Monday-Saturday 9:00 am to 6:00 pm
- From April 1 to October 31 Monday-Saturday 9:00 am to 8:00 pm
- December 1 April 30 there will be four (4) hours of free parking on Saturdays.
