PUBLIC APPOINTMENTS

The City of Stratford Council recently approved the creation of the Ad-Hoc Transit Committee. The Ad-Hoc Transit Committee will provide a forum for input and exchange of ideas on conventional and mobility transit related issues. The Committee will meet every two-months or at the call of the Chair.

Public appointments are open to Stratford residents and eligible electors who are at least 18 years of age. You can make a difference by serving on a City committee or board. Persons interested in being appointed to the Ad-hoc Committee are asked to complete and return an application no later than June 14, 2019. PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION – PROPOSED RENEWABLE NATURAL GAS PROJECT

The City of Stratford will be holding a Public Information Session for a proposed renewable natural gas project at Stratford's Water Pollution Control Plant on:

Thursday, June 13, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Ritsma Room, Burnside Agriplex, 357 McCarthy Road W, Stratford

The project would, if approved by City Council, involve the addition of new equipment at the West Gore Street plant to allow for large quantities of organic matter, including food waste, to be processed there. The goal is to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by diverting residential, commercial and industrial organic waste from landfill sites, and "co-digesting" that material at the Water Pollution Control Plant, along with sewage solids. The methane gas produced by the anaerobic digesters at the plant would be refined into natural gas, and then injected into the natural gas distribution system for use.

An Environmental Compliance Approval would be required from the Ontario Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks for the project to proceed, and consultation with citizens, stakeholders, regulatory agencies and First Nations is part of that process.
