STRATFORD AND PERTH COUNTY COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION

The City of Stratford and the County of Perth have each been awarded a Community Transportation Grant to launch a Community Transportation pilot project. This service will provide bus access from Stratford, Listowel, and St. Marys to intermodal transportation hubs in Kitchener and London, and connect the communities of **Atwood, Brunner, Gads Hill, Listowel, Millbank, Milverton, Mitchell, Monkton, Newton, Sebringville, St. Marys, and Stratford.** We hope to launch this service in the spring of 2020.
