Architectural Description: two storey yellow brick with a nearly flat roof; first floor; the windows are all rectangular, segmentally arched six panes over six panes; brick headers containing key stones are over each window on each floor; there is a door with a filled in transom to the right of the first window on the left; then nine more windows and a door on the extreme right side; second floor has twelve windows the same as the first floor; the left hand wall has no windows or doors and is made of red brick; the yellow brick is only on the front of the building.

The building is now the Stratford Hotel. It was erected by the Daly family and was originally a row of five identical housing units.
