Description: Three-storey structure with six over six, rectangular windows. This structure has original horizontal wood cladding beneath corrugated galvanized metal.

Between its construction and 1916, this building was most likely a carpenter's shop. Since its construction, it also been used as a chopping mill, a galvanized iron mill, and, most recently, a warehouse.

The building is now located in a primarily residential area but continues to serve as an important example of Stratford and its surrounding area's agricultural tradition.
