The Stratford Police Service is inviting written applications for the position of:

Auxiliary Police Constable

An Auxiliary Police Constable is a citizen who will volunteer their time to the Police Service as a means of contributing to our community. The mandate of the Auxiliary Unit is to assist the parent police service with various community events. Assistance may come in the form of traffic duty, crowd control as well as public relations for the Stratford Police Service.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 19 years of age.
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada.
- Of good moral character and habits.
- Physically and mentally able to perform the duties of the position, having regard for his or her own safety and the safety of members of the public. Proof of medical fitness from a licensed medical practitioner is to be submitted prior to commencement of the training program with Stratford Police Service. Costs to be borne by the applicant.
- Minimum Grade 12 education or equivalent.
- Possess current First Aid and CPR Certification.
- Provide signed consent for Enhanced Police Records Check and Consent for a Criminal Record Check for a Sexual Offence for which a pardon has been granted or issued. Consent forms are provided by Stratford Police Service and must be completed when personally submitting resume.
- Successfully complete all interviews, examinations and training program.
- Possess valid Ontario Driver's License.
- Willing to commit at least two years to the Auxiliary Policing Unit.
- Willing to commit a minimum of 12 hours volunteer time per month.

TRAINING SCHEDULE:

Upon acceptance to the program, training will involve approximately 40 - 50 hours of initial training. Training dates and times will consist of evening and weekends, that are yet to be determined. The training will take place in September 2021, subject to restrictions which could be in place due to Covid 19 pandemic.

Prior to a conditional offer of acceptance, potential candidates will be required to undergo a background check to determine their suitability for the position.
